We all remember the story of the "good Samaritan."

Jesus tells us a story about a man who was beaten and robbed and left on the side of the road to die. Several people passed him by without offering any help at all.

One man, a priest, crossed the road so he wouldn't have to look at him. Finally a man from Samaria came by and saw the man and had compassion on him and treated his wounds, put him on his donkey and took him to an inn and paid for his medical expenses. Jesus asks us, "Which of these three do you think was a neighbor to the man who fell into the hands of robbers?" The correct answer was "The one who had mercy on him."

I John 4:7 says, "Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God."

II Cor. 8: 9 says, "For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, so that you through His poverty might become rich."

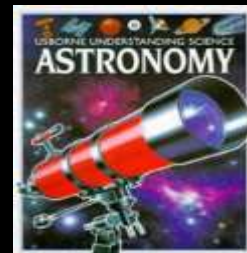
