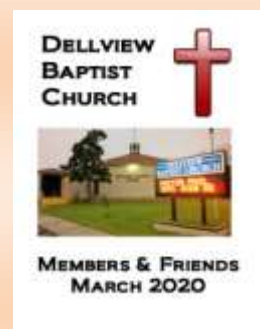

Did you hear the one about the little boy who tells his mother, "You know how the Bible says we are made from dust and to dust we shall return? Well, someone's under my bed and I can't tell if he's coming or going."

Perhaps you know one of my Dad's favorite songs -

*I was born about 2,000 years ago and there isn't very much that I don't know
I saw Jonah swallow the whale and Daniel pull the lion's tail
And I'll whip the man who says it isn't so*

A lot of people might have heard the dust-to-dust reference but not realize it was actually in the Bible. Even fewer people know who Jonah was or why Daniel was messing with a lion. They would probably suspect Daniel might be involved in animal abuse and Jonah was probably a disgruntled Sea World employee. I think the answer is that we as Christians aren't doing a very good job of passing our faith to our children, grandchildren, and the world in general.

Most of us grew up with Christian parents or grandparents who eagerly shared the wonderful stories from the Bible in order to establish a foundation of faith in us.
